Organisation

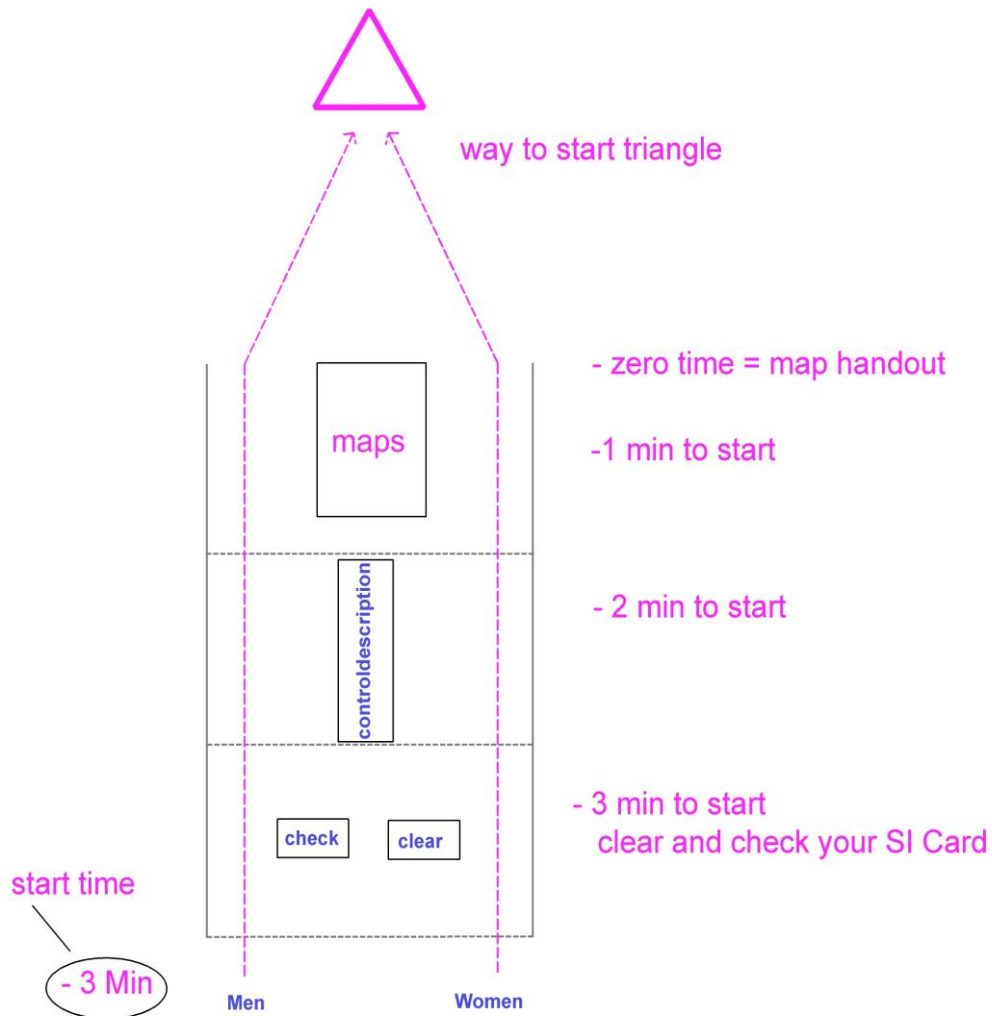

Training:

Additional trainings available from Monday until Wednesday for a fee of € 3,- per map. All areas are in the Faakersee/Rosental region. Marking stripes are out in the forest.

Start for Sprint/Long distance:

Call up will be at -3, to check and clear your Si-Card. At -2 you can pick up the control-description. At -1 you stand in front of your map-box. At Zero it will be the time start. It is the athletes' responsibility to pick up the correct map.



Mass Start for Relay:

The map for the first runners is on the floor. The map for the second and third runner is on the pole. We give you a demonstration half an hour before zero time.

Clothing Return:

There will be no official clothing transfer. All clothes, which are left at the start, must be returned by a team member.

Water/ Refreshments:

We offer refreshments at the finish area in all three competitions. Water supply stations in the forest are only available in the long-distance race.



Final Entries and Final Payment:

Complete entries with full payment are to be received by Wednesday, 30th August, using the Final Entry form on the website. Only minor changes can be accepted.

Sprint Competition Information, Thursday 15. September

Follow the signs to Arnoldstein / Waldpark Stadium.

Course planner: Stefan Hartinger **Controller:** Bernhard Lieber

Start: 600 m marked route from car parking. Warming up is only allowed from car parking along the marked route in open land and roads around the football stadium.

Finish: The finish area is on the main square in Arnoldstein, where also will be the welcome-ceremony after the sprint race. Finishing athletes must not return to the start. Please organize your own clothing transport to the finish.

Details of the Terrain:

Suburban area, mixed with some wooded hills and open lands- Dubb spikes are allowed- Don't cross the railway tracks, you will be faster if you use the tunnel. Watch out for bikers and vehicles during the race!

Relay Competition Information, Friday 16. September

Follow the signs to Hotel Mittagsgogel in Ledenitzen.

Course planner: Bernhard Lieber **Controller:** Stefan Hartinger

Start/Finish: Mass start. Maps are on the pole. First runners get the maps on the floor.

Change/Hand over: Incoming runners will not be called up. You will be able to watch them at the public control, 3 minutes before handover. There will be a demonstration half an hour before zero time.

Details of the Terrain: Typical continental European contours with conifer forest, some parts are green due to undergrowth of tall grass in the forest, some steep part in first part of the race.

Map: Ledenitzen, scale: 1:10.000, contour interval: 5 m, survey & draw: August 2011. Printed in Prettex-Quality, waterproof, not tear-proof.

1.100 m marked route from car parking. Warming up area and a map extract is available on the way to the start.

Terrain Details:

Rock fallen area with a lot of details, distinctive type of terrain, wet and dry.

Arnoldstein, scale: 1:10.000, contour interval: 5 m, survey & draw: August 2011. Printed in Prettex-Quality, waterproof, not tear-proof.
